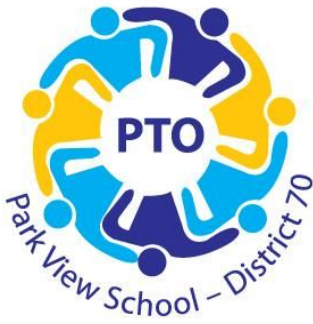
General

- ☆ **SOCIAL COMMITTEE** Help with events during the year including International Night.

- ☆ **TEACHER APPRECIATION COMMITTEE** Food and treats are provided to the faculty during conferences and during Teacher Appreciation week (May). Treats may be baked goods, fruit/veggie plates, cheese/crackers, etc. The food is dropped off in the morning. No serving/clean up involved. Keep an eye out for emails!

- ☆ **FAMILY BREAKFASTS** Family breakfasts are held before school on two Fridays in the spring. Volunteers are needed for set-up in the evening and in the morning for set-up and clean-up.

Special Events

- ☆ **BAKE SALE** Event is held during the Fun Fair in September. Volunteers are needed to help sort and price donated baked goods, to sell items and to clean-up.

- ☆ **BOOK FAIR** Event is held during conferences. We need volunteers to work the fair as cashiers, to set-up and breakdown the book fair, and/or to help the children with their selections.

- ☆ **FUN FAIR** Event is held in September. Volunteers are needed to help with bouncy house supervision, food sales, face painting and crafts, set-up and clean-up.
