Plan

Mr. Voehringer stated that the Covid positivity rates in Morton Grove were 11.05%, which is the red zone, on 11/23/20 and dropped to 6.58%, which is the orange zone, on 11/29/20. He will be following up this week with the Skokie Department of Public Health on protocols for return to learning.

There are not hard numbers for Parent-Teacher conferences yet, but there was a high participation. They were all virtual.

There will be home visits for students who have low participation in remote learning. There will be a staff member that will work one on one with at risk students with a check in, check out process. Matt Condon, Darcy Willis, and Kelly Allen will be doing virtual walk throughs of the classrooms to see how many students are engaged and to do a quality check.

Evaluations for 1st and 2nd year nontenured teachers will be completed by March 1st. Nontenured teachers in their 3rd and 4th year have the option to be evaluated.

From now until winter break it is up to the teacher whether they want to work from home or at school. They just have to let the district know if they will be coming in. About one third of the teachers are working from school right now.
